GEAR students will receive a 50% tuition award in their final year of study.

Guaranteed Rochester Accelerated Degree in Education (GRADE)

GRADE is a BA/BS + MS program for students interested in becoming educators. GRADE students choose any undergraduate major and are guaranteed admission to the Margaret Warner Graduate School of Education and Human Development with the Steven Harrison Scholarship, equal to one third of tuition, for each of their years at Rochester.
